Dear Parents,

Thank you for your continued support of St. Maximilian Kolbe School. We remain dedicated to the personal growth of each student within a Christ-centered community where all are accepted and valued. We believe you and your children benefit from our commitment to developing the whole person as a Catholic Christian.

As we plan for the 2018-19 school year, our highest priority is maintaining those standards of achievement that distinguish our school as a National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence. Each year the cost of operating the school increases. Teacher and staff salaries, benefits, employees' pension plan, building upkeep, materials and supplies, as well as technology upgrades require more revenue making tuition adjustments necessary. Still, tuition does not cover the total cost of education. The difference is made up by contributions to the Annual Fund, the fundraising efforts of the Home & School Association, and by the generosity of the parish community through weekly collections. We are grateful to all who support these opportunities for parish stewardship. Our budget projections indicate that only a small increase is necessary. Good news, indeed!

For 2018-19, we have streamlined the re-registration process to make registration more user friendly and efficient. **In early January, instructions for a convenient new roll over re-registration will be available.**

Please know that we remain committed to providing a Blue Ribbon, faith-filled Catholic Education for your children next year and for many years to come.
