FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is MiniTHON?

MiniTHON is a student lead philanthropic opportunity that is based off of the PanHellenic THON at Penn State University. It is open to any elementary, high school or university that would like to raise funds for Four Diamonds. When you donate to MiniTHON, you support the powerful movement of kids helping kids through philanthropy and community service.

What happens at SSPP's MiniTHON?

This is a fun filled social event for 6th, 7th and 8th graders. The event is open on a first come first serve basis to the SSPP students and parishioner children, as well as the local Catholic schools. We will have a DJ, games and contests, selfie booth and props. In the past there has also been an appearance by the Penn State Nittany Lion. Kids dance as much or as little as they like. It is NOT a dance marathon. Just a fun time to raise money for an important cause.

Who does the Money go to?

Monies raised will go to the 401c Four Diamonds that was started in the 1970's by the Millard Family who lost their son to cancer. This is the same Four Diamonds that Penn State's THON dance marathon goes to. 75% of the money that Four Diamonds raises supports medical research at the Penn State Children's Hospital in Hershey. The remainder goes to pay 100% of the medical bills/expenses for those Four Diamonds families whose children are receiving treatment at Penn State Children's Hospital. Since 1993, MiniTHON alone has raised over \$23 million and inspires more than 700,000 students and 235 schools to bring hope to families in need and help support cutting edge research. As an aside, Four Diamonds spends their donations wisely. 91 cents of every donated dollar goes directly to helping kids with cancer.

Can I drop off or pick up my child other than the start and end time of the event?

Yes. We understand that there are sporting events and other obligations that may require your child to be dropped off later than the start time, or picked up prior to the end time. Please just mark it on the front of the form the approximate time of the needed drop-off and/or pick up. Please be advised that A PARENT MUST COME DOWN TO THE CHURCH BASEMENT TO SIGN A CHILD OUT OF THE EVENT EVEN IF THE CHILD IS STAYING FOR THE ENTIRE TIME.

What if my child wants to come home prior to the end time, but I (we) didn't mark it down on the form?

If your child calls or texts you that they want to come home earlier than anticipated, please just come to the church basement sign in/out table and let us know that your child needs to be picked up.

Will drinks and snacks be provided?

Yes. Snacks and beverages will be provided for the participants. If your child has a food allergy, please let us know, and we will have an appropriate snack available for your child. There is no outside food or drinks allowed in the church basement. If you wish to provide a specific snack for your child due to food allergies, you as the parent must bring it in for your child at the sign in desk.

How will the event be supervised?

We will have parents there to chaperone and supervise the event that have all of their clearances. We will also have a nurse or medic throughout the evening for safety purposes. We welcome any additional parents that have their clearances to help chaperone. You can stay the entire event or just a few hours. There is a space to check off if you would like to chaperone on the form.
